DETAILED ITINERARY

Day 1, 06 Aug 21

 Private Transportation from San Jose to Arenal / Travel time: 3 hours / Private

Right after you go through immigration and customs one representative will meet you at **the Juan Santamaria International Airport (SJO) exit** to load the luggage into the vehicle and transfer you to the hotel. The hotel for tonight is close to **San Jose city**, located 25-15 minutes away from the airport. During the short drive, you will receive a **brief introduction to Costa Rica** and some recommendations for your trip. The guide will explain your itinerary in detail once you are in the hotel.

La Fortuna is home to the greater Arenal recreation area, the entire region is paradise on Earth for **outdoor adventurers**. Volcanic views grace the landscape and heat several **geothermal hot springs**. A lake and rivers beckon you toward **aquatic adventure**. Refreshing **waterfalls** reward you after **hikes**, offering crisp pools and spectacular views.

Arenal Volcano is one of **Costa Rica's most notable natural features**. Standing at 5,437 feet (1,657 meters), this volcano has been resting (i.e. not active) since 2010. However, it is no less majestic to behold, as it's practically a behemoth against the region's perfect skies. **Rising above the rainforest** that surrounds its base, Arenal Volcano frames the skyline with near-perfect **symmetry**.

Day 2, 07 Aug 21



Horseback Riding To The Fortuna Waterfall / Regular / **Photoshoot Included.**

On this **horseback ride to the La Fortuna Waterfall and Replica Indigenous Village**, you will see the spectacular Arenal Volcano and dormant Cerro Chato Volcano off in the distance with gorgeous green countryside all around. The horses are sturdy and friendly bred for tourism and are well adapted to the wet, jungle environment of Costa Rica.

This is a slow and easy ride up to the waterfall, so it is perfect for first-time riders, families, or people who really want to soak in the surrounding natural beauty. Throughout your 1-hour **La Fortuna horseback ride through rainforest trails**, your guide will point out wildlife, and you will get to see beautiful views of the green countryside and the breathtaking Arenal volcano.

There are over 300 steps to get to the base of the **La Fortuna Waterfall** along a private trail. The last part of the hike down you will have to go over a few slippery rocks, but the trek is worth it! When you reach the bottom, you'll have an opportunity to take lots of pictures and swim in the cool waters of one of the largest waterfalls in Arenal.

This where you will get to relax and cool off in the river pools if conditions are suitable! When you're ready, take your time as you head back up the trail and staircase to where your horses will be waiting to take you back to the ranch. This is an excellent, well-rounded horseback ride in La Fortuna.

On your way back, you'll stop by a little thatched-roof cabin to learn about **the Maleku**, one of Costa Rica's few remaining indigenous tribes that originates in the Arenal area. You will get to learn a little bit more about the Maleku culture and see the Maleku traditional handicrafts. You may even pick up a few words in Maleku like "kapi kapi!"

This tour will include a **photographer**.



Day 3, 08 Aug 21



Sky Tram - Sky Trek - Sky Walk / Regular


This is a great tour where you will do three amazing activities, Sky Trek, Sky Tram and Sky Walk. At Sky Trek in Arenal, you ride the **tram up the mountain**, for more than 800m (2600ft) of the magnificent aerial tramway up the glorious mountains of Arenal. You can enjoy the best views and appreciate true nature.


Then to get back to the base you will have to ride the **breathhtaking ziplines**, making it a perfect adventure activity with **no walking segments** you will get off and jump on to the next cable. You'll ride 7 cables that go up to 200m (656ft) in height and 750m (2460ft) in length where you will be astounded by its **impressive heights, speeds** that go up to 70km/h (43.5mph), **views**, and because you will be able to admire the surrounding mountains like in no other place.

The walk consists a little over 2 miles (3.5 km) long and lasts around 3 hours. The trail leads through the primary rainforest and includes **5 suspension bridges, 2 observation points, and 2 waterfalls**. Walking across the suspension bridges will provide you with a **new perspective** on the complexity of the rainforest.

The morning tour includes a **freestyle diving adventure** in a beautiful and secluded bay known as **Biezans Beach**. The afternoon tour is a truly amazing trip for nature lovers who can enjoy not only the experience itself but the **breathtaking sunset** on the Pacific Ocean. Cherish the sights of **humpback whales, dolphins, stingrays**, and other marine wildlife.

Onboard, you will have a selection of snacks and natural juices. As you cruise along the coast, enjoy the sea breeze, the **summer sunshine** of Costa Rica and this unique tropical paradise at its best. This tour includes a delicious **meal** before to end this tour.



Day 6, 11 Aug 21



Manuel Antonio National Park Guided Walk / Regular

The pace of this adventure is determined by the consensus of your group's abilities and interests. There is an **abundance of wildlife** you will want to stop and observe, all in its natural and **brehtaking habitat**. Watch **sloths** and numerous species of **monkeys** travel through the tree canopy as they hunt for nocturnal **silky anteaters** and several types of **non-poisonous snakes** resting in the **tropical rainforest**. Listen to the songs of the various **birds** as they glide above your group, curiously looking for adventure. At your convenience and leisure, you can stop and enjoy some local fresh fruits and refreshments as you pause to soak in the beautiful aesthetics. Enjoy some leisure time to **swim** at the pristine water of **the virgin beaches** inside of the national park, consider **the most beautiful beaches** of Costa Rica.
