## DETAILED ITINERARY

Day 1, 30 Dec 21



Private Transfer IN from Airport to Hotel / Private

Right after you go through immigration and customs one representative will meet you at **the Juan Santamaria International Airport (SJO) exit** to load the luggage into the vehicle and transfer you to the hotel. The hotel for tonight is close to **San Jose city**, located 25-15 minutes away from the airport. During the short drive, you will receive a **brief introduction to Costa Rica** and some recommendations for your trip. The guide will explain your itinerary in detail once you are in the hotel.

### San Jose

Costa Rica's capital and the **largest city in the country**, San Jose is considered to be among the most cosmopolitan cities in Latin America. Downtown San Jose is the busiest part of town. A maze of streets and avenues, here you can find most of the city's museums as well as several hotels and plazas.

In the center of the city, several attractions can be found, such as the **National Theater, the National Museum, and the Jade Museum**. Also, several parks like **Plaza de La Cultura and Parque Morazan** are interesting places to visit. In San Jose exist a wide variety for gastronomic, each corner of the city has great restaurants or the famous **Barrio Escalante**, a gastronomic center where high-quality food is offered. But for more local and typical food the central market offers tasty food.

## Day 2, 31 Dec 21



### San Jose City Tour / Private

During this journey you will visit the **National Theater**, also known as "The jewel of San José", a masterpiece in art and architecture built by Costa Ricans and completed in 1897. Then, **the Museum of Gold** (an archaeological interest site), then the **Central Market**, place full of the Costa Rican cultural heritage and traditions, where you will be able to browse and buy some local art crafts.

You will also visit the **Metropolitan Cathedral**. As you travel around the city, your guide will point you out several historically important or main buildings in our city, for example The Costa Rica University, The Old Train Station, The National Liquor Factory, The National Supreme Election Bureau, the Asamblea Legislativa (equivalent to The Congress), The Metallic Building, some parks and various sites of interest. This will be an introduction to the Capital City, and information about the economy, cultural, politics, religion and general current events. Also, you will visit an Art Gallery, where you will be able to get some **souvenirs** to take back home.

*NOTE: The entrance fee to the museums or the National Theatre is not included.*



## Day 3, 1 Jan 22



Irazu Volcano & Hacienda Orosi Hot Springs / Lunch included / Regular

In the morning a representative will meet you at the hotel to take you east from San Jose, to Cartago province. The **Irazu Volcano National** Park is located just a few kilometers from Cartago, and it is a relatively short and pleasant drive from your hotel in San Jose. The trip begins by driving to the **brehtaking summit** of the Irazu Volcano, on the way you will encounter all types of vegetation, from potato, onion, cauliflower farming among other important products for the nacional economy, depending on the elevation. Once in the National Park a **short and easy walk** to the up to a spectacular massive crater which has a lagoon with a mystical green color.

Then you will visit the city of Cartago admire the **Virgin of the Angels Basilica** that according to religious custom is a peregrination site for many believers.

After the visit to this beautiful church, you will head to Hacienda Orosi Hot Springs is located near the Tapanti National Park. This special place is surrounded by **rainforest and lush vegetation**, La Hacienda Orosi has been blessed by mother earth with **natural mineral hot springs**. These rich springs of mineral waters are filtered between the layers of the earth and spring in the middle of the rainforest at more than 65 degrees Celsius. The minerals, salts, and ions that compose this water **enrich the skin tissues, stimulate the senses**.



## Day 4, 2 Jan 22



Tortuga Island, From San Jose / Lunch included / Regular

This excursion departs from San Jose very early in the morning to Puntarenas, where you will board a yacht to Isla Tortuga (**Turtle Island**), a beautiful island located in the Gulf of Nicoya.

At Tortuga Island you will experience a day full of **beautiful skies**, great ocean views and **live music**. On board the yacht savory tropical fruits and refreshing natural drinks will be served. Then, you will explore the island, immersing yourself in the calm clear waters and **lush landscape**, where you can take **a swim**, sunbathe. Then a delicious lunch will be prepared by the crew.

Tortuga Island is composed of 120 hectares of gorgeous terrain, with 4 main hills; not to mention a 500 meter beach which is a recipient of the blue flag certification.

The journey to Tortuga Island will be on board a yacht equipped with 2 Cummins Marino 300 HP motors, radar, satellite navigation systems, VHF marine radio, clean bathrooms, and palatable drinking water.

A very experienced and international maritime license yacht captain and well trained crew will make sure you have a safe, enjoyable and unforgettable journey.



## Day 5, 3 Jan 22



Private Transfer OUT from Hotel to Airport / Private

All the good things come to an end. Say good-bye to beautiful **Costa Rica** and its people! On driver will pick you up at the hotel and take you straight to the **International Airport**. In Costa Rica, you must be at the airport **3 hours** before the departure time.
