Day 1, 11 Mar 22

### Tortuguero

Tortuguero is located in the north Caribbean of Costa Rica. Tortuguero is one of the most remote places in Costa Rica and is only accessible by boat or plane. This little village with strong **Afro-Caribbean roots** is best known for attracting hordes of sea turtles such as **Leatherback, Loggerhead, and Hawksbill turtles**. While peak turtle season is in July and August, the park and village have begun to attract travelers year-round. Tortuguero is great for families and adventure travelers to go on **jungle hikes**, do a **boat tour** in the canals of the National Park, or just relax at the lodge. The Canals of Tortuguero are known as Costa Rica’s Amazon-like rainforest there are more of **800 species of wildlife**, especially many types of birds.

## Day 3, 13 Mar 22

This morning, after breakfast, you have a **boat tour on the Tortuguero National Park** with the company of a local expert nature guide. The small boats go deep into the canals of the national park, further beyond where other boats can go. Due to the ability to explore further into the canals, you will have the opportunity to find rarer species of wildlife.

*NOTE: The entrance fee to Tortuguero National Park is not included. It is \$15 USD per person.*

This afternoon, your guide will take you to a private nature trail where you have an exploring **guided walk inside the jungle**. The walk is relaxed and slow pace as this is a flat trail. The rest of the day is at your leisure; you can relax at the **swimming pool**, take a cocktail admiring the river lagoon or spend the afternoon on the beach.

### Arenal Volcano

La Fortuna is home to the greater Arenal recreation area, the entire region is paradise on Earth for **outdoor adventurers**. Volcanic views grace the landscape and heat several **geothermal hot springs**. A lake and rivers beckon you toward **aquatic adventure**. Refreshing **waterfalls** reward you after **hikes**, offering crisp pools and spectacular views.

Arenal Volcano is one of **Costa Rica's most notable natural features**. Standing at 5,437 feet (1,657 meters), this volcano has been resting (i.e. not active) since 2010. However, it is no less majestic to behold, as it's practically a behemoth against the region's perfect skies. **Rising above the rainforest** that surrounds its base, Arenal Volcano frames the skyline with near-perfect **symmetry**.

Day 5, 15 Mar 22



In the morning, Sloth Tour (Sloth Territory) / Regular

The sweet smiling face of the **Costa Rican sloth** is rapidly becoming the iconic symbol of the country's amazing **rainforest wildlife**. All set, you will walk for about 1.2 kilometers through the beautiful rainforest looking for our lazy friend, the sloth.

You will be searching out both **2-toed** and **3-toed sloths**. Although similar, they have distinct differences. The 2-toed Sloth, being nocturnal, can be found sleeping high up in the treetops. More active during daytime hours, the 3-toed Sloth slowly moves through the branches eating leaves, often with a young sloth hugging on for the ride.

And as a bonus, you will also get great views of a **variety of birds, brightly-colored toucans, iguanas**, and more.



In the afternoon, Arenal Hanging Bridges / Regular

The guided tour in the Arenal Hanging Bridges is magical! A professional naturalist will be able to tell you the names of the plants and animals that make their home near **the base of the Arenal Volcano**. This version of the tour typically takes a little longer since you will want to stop and observe some of the plants and animals. There are over **350 species of birds and over 700 species of plants**, so you will see something new no matter where you look. Along the trail, you'll take in expansive views from **6 hanging bridges**.

Then it's time to head to the **Paradise Hot Springs**, perfect for relax in natural thermal water **pools** and **jacuzzis** of different temperatures with focused hydromassage for back, legs, and feet.
