DETAILED ITINERARY

Day 1, 12 Dec 21



Private Transfer IN from SJO Airport to Arenal Volcano area / Travel time: 3 hours.

Right after you go through immigration and customs one representative will meet you at **the Juan Santamaria International Airport (SJO) exit** to load the luggage into the vehicle and transfer you to the hotel. The hotel for tonight is close to **Arenal Volcano area**. During the drive, you will receive a **brief introduction to Costa Rica** and some recommendations for your trip. The guide will explain your itinerary in detail once you are in the hotel.

La Fortuna is home to the greater Arenal recreation area, the entire region is paradise on Earth for **outdoor adventurers**. Volcanic views grace the landscape and heat several **geothermal hot springs**. A lake and rivers beckon you toward **aquatic adventure**. Refreshing **waterfalls** reward you after **hikes**, offering crisp pools and spectacular views. Arenal Volcano is one of **Costa Rica's most notable natural features**. Standing at 5,437 feet (1,657 meters), this volcano has been resting (i.e. not active) since 2010. However, it is no less majestic to behold, as it's practically a behemoth against the region's perfect skies. **Rising above the rainforest** that surrounds its base, Arenal Volcano frames the skyline with near-perfect **symmetry**.

Day 2, 13 Dec 21



Arenal Volcano Walking Tour / Regular

The trails in **Arenal National Park** and other nearby **Arenal Reserves** are generally flat and not very strenuous, perfect for a leisurely and informative guided walk with a professional nature guide. You will hike through well-groomed, **easy trails** that skirt the base of the Arenal Volcano and Lake Arenal Area. This part of the Arenal Volcano had sections that were devastated by **the lava flow of 1968**, so some areas have very little vegetation. This guided walk provides **perfect photo opportunities** and **magnificent views** of the impressive Arenal Volcano, the pristine Lake Arenal and the extinct volcano Cerro Chato. There are parts of each trail that has forested areas where your nature guide will try to spot **birds, monkeys and other animals** in their natural habitat.



Day 3, 14 Dec 21



In the morning, ATV Single / Regular

Today you will enjoy a 2.5-hour tour going on fun trails at a private farm right below the Arenal Volcano. you will ride an ATV through fun trails with diverse conditions as rock bottom, gravel, dirt or muddy roads, bump tracks and pastures on the volcano base slopes. If weather allows favorable visibility conditions, we make a short stop to appreciate the spectacular view of La Fortuna and Arenal Volcano before we head to the Arenal river.



Late afternoon, you have a Cooking Class & Salsa Dance Lesson / Dinner included / Regular

Costa Rica has **amazing cuisine**: it is healthy, natural, and very easy to learn how to cook it. That is why you will be wanting to take back local spices and try some of our favorite recipes back home with your friends and families. These **cooking classes** have been planned as a great way to get to know other travelers and hang out with a knowledgeable local "chef". But the night gets even better because as soon as you finish cooking, you'll be able to sit down to the delicious meal you helped cook up and chat about the "Pura Vida" of Costa Rica. After dinner, you head to **the dance floor** to learn how to dance to some of the favorite **Latin beats** (salsa, merengue, cumbia y bachata).



Day 4, 15 Dec 21



Sky Tram, Sky Trek & Sky Walk / Lunch included.

This is a great tour where you will do three amazing activities, Sky Trek, Sky Tram and Sky Walk. At Sky Trek in Arenal, you ride the **tram up the mountain**, for more than 800m (2600ft) of the magnificent aerial tramway up the glorious mountains of Arenal. You can enjoy the best views and appreciate true nature.

Then to get back to the base you will have to ride the **brehtaking ziplines**, making it a perfect adventure activity with **no walking segments** you will get off and jump on to the next cable. You'll ride 7 cables that go up to 200m (656ft) in height and 750m (2460ft) in length where you will be astounded by its **impressive heights, speeds** that go up to 70km/h (43.5mph), **views**, and because you will be able to admire the surrounding mountains like in no other place.

The walk consists a little over 2 miles (3.5 km) long and lasts around 3 hours. The trail leads through the primary rainforest and includes **5 suspension bridges, 2 observation points, and 2 waterfalls**. Walking across the suspension bridges will provide you with a **new perspective** on the complexity of the rainforest.

At the end, and previous to return to your hotel, you will enjoy a **delicious lunch** at Sky Adventure Park.



Day 5, 16 Dec 21



Canyoning in the Lost Canyon / Lunch included / Regular

You'll rappel down **huge waterfalls, jump into pools, zip down guided rappels, downclimb** the canyon walls and river boulders, and **hike up** through the **rainforest**.

Start the rappelling-leg of your canyoning journey with the first waterfall referred to as the "Baby", a small-sized 10 feet waterfall that allows you to ease your way into learning the ropes. You will soon reach what it's called the "Big Boy", the second largest waterfall. About half-way through your rappel, you'll hear the call to "LET GO!" a few moments later you'll experience your **first guided free fall!** Finally, you will get **the largest Lost Canyon challenge:** an exciting 200 feet waterfall rappel.

At the end of this tour, enjoy a **delicious typical lunch**.



Day 6, 17 Dec 21



Private Transportation from Arenal to SJO Airport / Travel time: 3 hours.

All the good things come to an end. Say good-bye to beautiful **Costa Rica** and its people! One driver will pick you up at the hotel and take you straight to the **Juan Santamaria International Airport (SJO)**.

In Costa Rica, you must be at the airport **3 hours** before the departure time.
