Day 1, 14 Feb 23

 Private Transfer IN from Airport to Hotel

Tortuguero is located in the north Caribbean of Costa Rica. Tortuguero is one of the most remote places in Costa Rica and is only accessible by boat or plane. This little village with strong **Afro-Caribbean roots** is best known for attracting hordes of sea turtles such as **Leatherback, Loggerhead, and Hawksbill turtles**. While peak turtle season is in July and August, the park and village have begun to attract travelers year-round. Tortuguero is great for families and adventure travelers to go on **jungle hikes**, do a **boat tour** in the canals of the National Park, or just relax at the lodge. The Canals of Tortuguero are known as Costa Rica's Amazon-like rainforest there are more of **800 species of wildlife**, especially many types of birds.

After breakfast, you will continue to La Pavona dock, where you will board the special boat that will take you to the lodge immersed in the jungle.

This afternoon, you will have a **guided tour to the Village of Tortuguero** where you will visit the Turtle Museum and walk around the town to learn about the relaxed way of life in the Caribbean. Your guide will explain to you how this village developed and why they changed their minds about **turtle conservation**.

The rest of the day is at your leisure; you can relax at the **swimming pool**, take a cocktail admiring the river lagoon or spend the afternoon on the beach.




Sloth Tour (Sloth Territory)

You will be searching out both **2-toed** and **3-toed sloths**. Although similar, they have distinct differences. The 2-toed Sloth, being nocturnal, can be found sleeping high up in the treetops. More active during daytime hours, the 3-toed Sloth slowly moves through the branches eating leaves, often with a young sloth hugging on for the ride.

And as a bonus, you will also get great views of a **variety of birds, brightly-colored toucans, iguanas**, and more.



The woods serve as a sanctuary for a large number of mammals and innumerable species of insects, amphibians, amazing plants and colorful birds, a paradise for birdwatchers.

The hotel is run by the Chacon Family, whom arrived in Savegre in 1954 and were the first pioneers settling down in this valley. Over **170 bird species** have been observed in the area and its multiple hiking trails in the **Cloud Forest**. This is known as one of the best places in the country to **observe quetzals**, who live here year-round.
