Day 1, 28 Jan 23



Private Transfer IN from Airport to Hotel / Private

Right after you go through immigration and customs one representative will meet you at **the Juan Santamaria International Airport (SJO) exit** to load the luggage into the vehicle and transfer you to the hotel. The hotel for tonight is close to **San Jose city**, located 25-15 minutes away from the airport. During the short drive, you will receive a **brief introduction to Costa Rica** and some recommendations for your trip. The guide will explain your itinerary in detail once you are in the hotel.

Costa Rica's capital and the **largest city in the country**, San Jose is considered to be among the most cosmopolitan cities in Latin America. Downtown San Jose is the busiest part of town. But for more local and typical food the central market offers tasty food.



Tortuguero is located in the north Caribbean of Costa Rica. Tortuguero is one of the most remote places in Costa Rica and is only accessible by boat or plane. This little village with strong **Afro-Caribbean roots** is best known for attracting hordes of sea turtles such as **Leatherback, Loggerhead, and Hawksbill turtles**. While peak turtle season is in July and August, the park and village have begun to attract travelers year-round. Tortuguero is great for families and adventure travelers to go on **jungle hikes**, do a **boat tour** in the canals of the National Park, or just relax at the lodge. The Canals of Tortuguero are known as Costa Rica's Amazon-like rainforest there are more of **800 species of wildlife**, especially many types of birds.

The best natural expedition awaits you today. Your expert guide will meet you early at the hotel. You will start traveling northeast to the Caribbean lowlands. You will stop for breakfast at a local restaurant in Guapiles town. After breakfast, you will continue to La Pavona dock, there you will board the special boat that will take you to the lodge immersed in the jungle.

This afternoon, you will have a **guided tour to the Village of Tortuguero** and walk around the town to learn about the relaxed way of life in the Caribbean. Your guide will explain to you how this village developed and why they changed their minds about **turtle conservation**.

Lunch and dinner are included at the hotel.



Day 5, 01 Feb 23

This morning, after breakfast, you have a **boat tour on the Tortuguero National Park** with the company of a local expert nature guide. The small boats go deep into the canals of the national park, further beyond where other boats can go. Due to the ability to explore further into the canals, you will have the opportunity to find rarer species of wildlife.

NOTE: The entrance fee to Tortuguero National Park is not included. It is \$15 USD per person.

This afternoon, your guide will take you to a private nature trail where you have an exploring **guided walk inside the jungle**. The walk is relaxed and slow pace as this is a flat trail. The rest of the day is at your leisure; you can relax at the **swimming pool**, take a cocktail admiring the river lagoon or spend the afternoon on the beach.

Lunch and dinner are included at the hotel.



Day 6, 02 Feb 23

Today after breakfast, the guide will meet you at the main dock of the hotel to return by boat to Pavona's dock; from there continue with land transportation to Guapiles town where you will have another **delicious Caribbean lunch**. After the meal, a representative will pick you up to take you to the next destination of this journey

Arenal Volcano

La Fortuna is home to the greater Arenal recreation area, the entire region is paradise on Earth for **outdoor adventurers**. Volcanic views grace the landscape and heat several **geothermal hot springs**. A lake and rivers beckon you toward **aquatic adventure**. Refreshing **waterfalls** reward you after **hikes**, offering crisp pools and spectacular views.

Arenal Volcano is one of **Costa Rica's most notable natural features**. Standing at 5,437 feet (1,657 meters), this volcano has been resting (i.e. not active) since 2010. However, it is

no less majestic to behold, as it's practically a behemoth against the region's perfect skies. **Rising above the rainforest** that surrounds its base, Arenal Volcano frames the skyline with near-perfect **symmetry**.

Day 7, 03 Feb 23

🚶 Hanging Bridges Nature Walk / Regular

A professionally bilingual guide will pick you up in your hotel and drive to one of **the best viewpoints of the Arenal Volcano** high atop a hill across the valley from the iconic volcano. Some trails and bridges bring you as close as you could ever hope to get to the birds, flowers, and the lush vegetation of this **primary rainforest**.

The trails are designed for all ability levels and cover a total of about 2 miles. Once you are on walking along, you will be able to admire **the great diversity of flora and fauna** typically found in the tropical rainforest and also have the opportunity to see many different birds and plant species. Walk right into the forest along several stretches of hanging bridges overlooking the tree canopy along easy, safe and beautiful trails with views of the Arenal Volcano.



Day 8, 04 Feb 23



Arenal Volcano Walking Tour / Regular

The trails in **Arenal National Park** and other nearby **Arenal Reserves** are generally flat and not very strenuous, perfect for a leisurely and informative guided walk with a professional nature guide. You will hike through well-groomed, **easy trails** that skirt the base of the Arenal Volcano and Lake Arenal Area. This part of the Arenal Volcano had sections that were devastated by **the lava flow of 1968**, so some areas have very little vegetation.

This guided walk provides **perfect photo opportunities** and **magnificent views** of the impressive Arenal Volcano, the pristine Lake Arenal and the extinct volcano Cerro Chato. There are parts of each trail that has forested areas where your nature guide will try to spot **birds, monkeys and other animals** in their natural habitat.



La Fortuna Waterfall Hike & Swim / Regular

You will love the **hike down** to this waterfall near the town of La Fortuna because you can see all of **the natural beauty of the rainforest** as well as the birds and wildlife that live there. Once you arrive at the **La Fortuna Waterfall**, prepare to be blown away by the beauty of this impressive waterfall! You will also be able to swim and take amazing photos!

Get ready because there are 500 steps to get down to the waterfall and of course 500 steps to get back up. Many people take breaks on their way to soak up **the lush rainforest, tropical birds** and variety of wildlife that you may be lucky enough to see. When you reach the bottom, you will be blown away by the beauty of **this towering waterfall** and have plenty of opportunities to relax on the rocks and admire the views. You can also **take a swim** in the cool, refreshing clear-water pools along the left-hand side of the waterfall.

You can rinse off in the showers and change into dry clothes and take part in a delicious tropical fruit snack with your guide.



Day 9, 05 Feb 23

 Shared Transfer from Arenal to Monteverde, Lake Crossing / Shuttle Service

The trip combines comfortable **door to door** minivan transfers with a fun and **scenic cruise** across the tranquil **Lake Arenal**, where you will experience beautiful views of **the majestic volcano** and the forested **Tilaran Mountain Range**. You will also have the chance to see a variety of wetland birds such as kingfishers, flycatchers, waders and other exotic species that abound on the lakeshore.

You will be picked up from your hotel in **Arenal** and be driven to the Lake Arenal dam, where you will board a **covered boat**. This is where the scenic 45-minute cruise across the lake begins. Next, you will begin the impressive 1.5-hour journey up the mountainside on a steep road offering stunning views of the lush, green valley. You will be driven directly to your **Monteverde** area hotel.

IMPORTANT: Passengers should expect to carry their bags/luggage to and from the boat. Drivers will do their best to help if you have any problems with carrying heavy bags. Just let them know in advance.



Monteverde

Home to cool, **misty cloud forests**, and deep **green foliage almost everywhere** you look, there's no mistaking that you've stepped away from everyday life. If **spending time in nature** is at the top of your travel to-do list, then you'll get your **fill of adventure** in this

part of Costa Rica's Central Highlands. From **zip-lining** across a canopy to tours of **coffee plantations**, there are **plenty of activities** to keep you moving in the fresh air. Monteverde is translated as "green mountain", and once you've reached the mountaintop, you'll first come upon the quaint town of **Santa Elena**. Here you'll find gift stores, accommodations, a bus stop, restaurants, cafes, a supermarket, banks and much more. Though Monteverde proper does not have a town center, it is comprised of a dirt road that leads to the **Cloud Forest Reserve**. Spread out along this walkable road are hotels, cafes, restaurants, galleries, and **excellent views**

🚶 Night Walk Tour / Regular

Experience Costa Rica's spectacular nature on this **night-time excursion** to the Monteverde Cloud Forest. After a convenient hotel pickup, learn about the region's wildlife from an informative local guide and watch the forest come alive at night. Spot **bats, frogs**, and rare creatures like **kinkajous, ocelots, porcupines**, and **olingos**.



Day 10, 06 Feb 23



Sky Tram / Sky Walk Guided / Regular

With the Sky Tram and Sky Walk, you will experience a **different way to admire the forest**. Once you arrive at the park, you will start with the first Sky Walk. Which consists of **walking** is a little over 2 miles (3.5 km) long and lasts around 3 hours. The trail leads through the primary rainforest and includes **5 suspension bridges, 2 observation points, and 2 waterfalls**. Walking across the suspension bridges will provide you with a **new perspective** on the complexity of the rainforest.

The next activity is the Sky Tram, during which you'll board a **gondola and ascend** through the rainforest. This tram goes slow and provides you with ample opportunities to **engage in the forest and search for animals**. The ride ends at an observation deck, where you'll enjoy views of the Arenal Volcano and Lake Arenal perfect place to the **perfect picture**.



Day 11, 07 Feb 23



Transfer to Manuel Antonio Beach with Tarcoles Safari Boat / Lunch included / Regular

This morning, you'll have a transfer to the Manuel Antonio area. On the way, you will have a **safari boat tour at Tarcoles River**. This is a great way to break up the long, 5-hour drive from **Monteverde to Manuel Antonio Beach** because you are bound to see a **multitude of wildlife** including the famous, huge, **20-ft American crocodiles** that inhabit the Carara Biological Reserve area of the Tarcoles River.

Keep your eyes peeled for a rare sighting of the **Scarlet Macaw** and over fifty other species of birds you can see there. Your guide will point out the often difficult-to-see wildlife along this **two-hour boat tour** of the Tarcoles River and into the **Guacalillo Mangrove Estuary**. A delicious lunch is included at the end of the boat tour.

From there you will continue your way to the amazing Manuel Antonio area.

Walking tour to Cocovado National Park San Pedrillo Station / Lunch included / Regular

The Corcovado National Park is home to over 140 species of mammals, 120 species of reptiles, 6000 species of insects and over 400 kinds of birds. Besides, in this spectacular park, there are 500 species of trees and 150 species of orchids. That is why the National Geographic Magazine called it the **most biologically intense place on Earth**.

San Pedrillo Ranger Station is 30 minutes from Drake Bay, by boat. This tour includes a hike on the trails into the jungle and, after lunch at the station, a visit to a **spectacular waterfall**, where a refreshing swim will be more than welcome after the walk. In this tour, you will discover the **primary forest** and several animals, birds and insects.



Day 17, 13 Feb 23



Boat transfer from Drake to Sierpe / Shuttle Service

The boat transfer from your hotel Drake Bay to Sierpe takes about **1 hour**. You will be navigating on the sea for 20 more minutes and then for 40 minutes you will ride on the **Sierpe River** where you can enjoy the mangroves and some animals, **as crocodiles and birds**.

Los Santos area is home of **Los Quetzales National Park**, a perfect place for hiking and admiring the nature, avid hikers will get reward with stunning views.

3 Days Tortuguero, Standard Room with Full board

A neat place to stay in a **truly exotic location**, Aninga Lodge offers private cabins connected by raised walkways. Keep a lookout for **birds, mammals, and other animals** while you stay and explore here—Tortuguero is absolutely teeming with wildlife.

The aninga is a long, lanky waterbird, just one over 300 bird species living or passing through the area. Aninga Lodge takes the **Spanish name for this bird**, and rightly so: the hotel stands up out of the water in a similar fashion. Just a few minutes away from **Tortuguero National Park** and across the main canal from town, it offers rooms **connected by wooden walkways and surrounded by trees and other plants**. The cabins and walkways are boosted off the ground to keep above wet soil and the many, many animals that call this forest home.

The cabins are **basic, clean, and private**. Each has its own bathroom, hot water shower, screened windows, and ceiling fans. While no cabins offer television or air conditioning, **birds, sloths, iguanas and monkeys** may make guest appearances in trees along the walkways.
