Day 1, 07 Feb 23

Costa Rica's capital and the **largest city in the country**, San Jose is considered to be among the most cosmopolitan cities in Latin America. Downtown San Jose is the busiest part of town. A maze of streets and avenues, here you can find most of the city's museums as well as several hotels and plazas. In the center of the city, several attractions can be found, such as the **National Theater, the National Museum, and the Jade Museum**. Also, several parks like **Plaza de La Cultura and Parque Morazan** are interesting places to visit. In San Jose exist a wide variety for gastronomic, each corner of the city has great restaurants or the famous **Barrio Escalante**, a gastronomic center where high-quality food is offered. But for more local and typical food the central market offers tasty food.

Right after you go through immigration and customs one representative will meet you at **the Juan Santamaria International Airport (SJO) exit** to load the luggage into the vehicle and transfer you to the hotel. The hotel for tonight is close to **San Jose city**, located 25-15 minutes away from the airport. During the short drive, you will receive a **brief introduction to Costa Rica** and some recommendations for your trip. The guide will explain your itinerary in detail once you are in the hotel.

Day 2, 08 Feb 23

 Evergreen Lodge /3 Days Tortuguero, Standard Room / Full board / 3 Stars
In: 08 Feb 2023 Out: 10 Feb 2023

The best natural expedition awaits you today. Your expert guide will meet you early at the hotel. You will start traveling northeast to the Caribbean lowlands. You will stop for breakfast at a local restaurant in Guapiles town. After breakfast, you will continue to La Pavona dock, there you will board the special boat that will take you to the lodge immersed in the jungle.

This afternoon, you will have a **guided tour to the Village of Tortuguero** and walk around the town to learn about the relaxed way of life in the Caribbean. Your guide will explain to you how this village developed and why they changed their minds about **turtle conservation**.

Lunch and dinner are included at the hotel.



Day 3, 09 Feb 23

This morning, after breakfast, you have a **boat tour on the Tortuguero National Park** with the company of a local expert nature guide. The small boats go deep into the canals of the national park, further beyond where other boats can go. Due to the ability to explore further into the canals, you will have the opportunity to find rarer species of wildlife.

NOTE: The entrance fee to Tortuguero National Park is not included. It is \$15 USD per person.

This afternoon, your guide will take you to a private nature trail where you have an exploring **guided walk inside the jungle**. The walk is relaxed and slow pace as this is a flat trail. The rest of the day is at your leisure; you can relax at the **swimming pool**, take a cocktail admiring the river lagoon or spend the afternoon on the beach.

Lunch and dinner are included at the hotel.

Today after breakfast, the guide will meet you at the main dock of the hotel to return by boat to Pavona's dock; from there continue with land transportation to Guapiles town where you will have another **delicious Caribbean lunch**. La Fortuna is home to the greater Arenal recreation area, the entire region is paradise on Earth for **outdoor adventurers**. Volcanic views grace the landscape and heat several **geothermal hot springs**. A lake and rivers beckon you toward **aquatic adventure**. Refreshing **waterfalls** reward you after **hikes**, offering crisp pools and spectacular views.

Arenal Volcano is one of **Costa Rica's most notable natural features**. Standing at 5,437 feet (1,657 meters), this volcano has been resting (i.e. not active) since 2010. However, it is no less majestic to behold, as it's practically a behemoth against the region's perfect skies. **Rising above the rainforest** that surrounds its base, Arenal Volcano frames the skyline with near-perfect **symmetry**.

These trails bring you as close as you would ever hope to see the rainforest and its inhabitants, as well as give you access to see **stunning views of the rainforest** **and** **mountains.**

After your adventure on the hanging bridges, you will head to the **Arenal Volcano National Park**. The trails are generally flat and not very strenuous, perfect for a **leisurely and informative guided walk**. Enjoy a delicious **lunch** at this point.

Then, you will finish the day at the stunning **La Fortuna Waterfall**. When you reach the entrance, you will have time to change into your bathing suit in case you want to cool off in the **cool pools that flow from the waterfall**. This is sure to be a good workout as there are 500 steps to get to the down to the waterfall, and 300 to get back up! When you reach the bottom, you'll have an opportunity to take lots of pictures and **swim in the cool waters** of one of the largest and most breathtaking waterfalls in Arenal!

Day 6, 12 Feb 23

 Shared Transfer from Arenal to Monteverde, Lake Crossing / / Shuttle Service

The trip combines comfortable **door to door** minivan transfers with a fun and **scenic cruise** across the tranquil **Lake Arenal**, where you will experience beautiful views of **the majestic volcano** and the forested **Tilaran Mountain Range**. You will also have the chance to see a variety of wetland birds such as kingfishers, flycatchers, waders and other exotic species that abound on the lakeshore.

You will be picked up from your hotel in **Arenal** and be driven to the Lake Arenal dam, where you will board a **covered boat**. This is where the scenic 45-minute cruise across the lake begins. Next, you will begin the impressive 1.5-hour journey up the mountainside on a steep road offering stunning views of the lush, green valley. You will be driven directly to your **Monteverde** area hotel.

IMPORTANT: Passengers should expect to carry their bags/luggage to and from the boat. Drivers will do their best to help if you have any problems with carrying heavy bags. Just let them know in advance.

Home to cool, **misty cloud forests**, and deep **green foliage almost everywhere** you look, there's no mistaking that you've stepped away from everyday life. If **spending time in nature** is at the top of your travel to-do list, then you'll get your **fill of adventure** in this part of Costa Rica's Central Highlands. From **zip-lining** across a canopy to tours of **coffee plantations**, there are **plenty of activities** to keep you moving in the fresh air. Monteverde is translated as "green mountain", and once you've reached the mountaintop, you'll first come upon the quaint town of **Santa Elena**. Here you'll find gift stores, accommodations, a bus stop, restaurants, cafes, a supermarket, banks and much more. Though Monteverde proper does not have a town center, it is comprised of a dirt road that leads to the **Cloud Forest Reserve**. Spread out along this walkable road are hotels, cafes, restaurants, galleries, and **excellent views**

🚶 Birdwatching Tour, Half Day / / Regular

From start to finish, the goal of this tour is to identify as many birds as possible. **Monteverde** is home to some **400 species of birds**, which are scattered among the forests and mountains of the region. During this tour, you will spend the morning hiking the Curi-Cancha trails and searching for birds. The tour lasts 5 to 6 hours depending on the endurance of the group.

The **Curi-Cancha Reserve** extends across 237 acres (96 ha) and protects both primary and secondary forests. It is one of the area's best birding sites, offering visitors the opportunity to see birds like the **orange-bellied trogon, keel-billed toucan, blue-crowned motmot, resplendent quetzal**, and **blue-throated golden tail**. Its trails are well maintained (although sometimes a bit muddy) and extend for several kilometers.



Day 7, 13 Feb 23

🚶 Monteverde Cloud Forest Reserve, Guided Walking Tour / / Regular

The tour is essentially a natural history walk in which you will learn about **the incredible diversity of flora and fauna** and many of the unique relationships various cloud forest species have with each other. Guides are equipped with a spotting telescope as well as binoculars and several informational guidebooks. Be sure to bring your cameras, as you can take pictures through the guide's scope. This walk normally takes about 3 hours.

The **Monteverde Cloud Forest Reserve** is where some of **the best-kept cloud forests** in all of Costa Rica can be found. It is a cloud forest, not a rainforest, due to its elevation of 4,724 feet (1,440 meters) above sea level.



Coffee & Chocolate Tour (Monteverde) / / Regular

The coffee tour takes participants on a journey through history. You will learn **the importance of coffee** in Costa Rica's past and current economy. You will walk through **the farm and factory** to see how the bean becomes the rich dark liquid that Costa Ricans love.

The famous **chocolate tour** is next. You will smell and taste different types of chocolate as your guide explains the cultural history behind the treat. The guide will also walk you through how the plant goes from seed to **pure ground cocoa**.

Listen to the songs of the various **birds** as they glide above your group, curiously looking for adventure. At your convenience and leisure, you can stop and enjoy some local fresh fruits and refreshments as you pause to soak in the beautiful aesthetics. Enjoy some leisure time to **swim** at the pristine water of **the virgin beaches** inside of the national park, consider **the most beautiful beaches** of Costa Rica.

The boat transfer from Sierpe to Drake Bay takes about **1 hour**. After crossing the river's mouth, we will be navigating on the sea for 20 more minutes. Every guest will be **dropped off hotel**.

It is also very common to see **dolphins and whales**. For lunch, you will go to a stunning San Josecito beach, where you will be able to do some hiking, more snorkeling or just relax



Day 12, 18 Feb 23



Walking tour to Cocovado National Park in Sirena Station / Lunch included / Regular

The Corcovado National Park is home to over 140 species of mammals, 120 species of reptiles, 6000 species of insects and over 400 kinds of birds. Besides, in this spectacular park, there are 500 species of trees and 150 species of orchids. That is why the National Geographic Magazine called it the **most biologically intense place on Earth**.

You will visit **Sirena Station** is located in the center of the park, there are more chances to spot animals such as tapirs, monkeys, crocodiles, birds and a lot more. During this tour, you will be exploring the trails walking in the jungle and along the coastline for **5 hours approximately**.

Located in the south Pacific of Costa Rica. Uvita is a small town, here are small shops, and souvenirs place. Nightlife is not big here in Uvita but there is still several bar and restaurant options. The town itself is spread out and stretches from the beach area and back into the **mountains**.

It is the primary entrance to the **incredibly beautiful Marino Ballena National Park** which protects both coastline and sea. The park is most well-known for the Humpback Whales that migrate here annually to rear their young. The backdrop for the area is just as spectacular with towering **lush green mountains** shrouded in clouds that quickly descend to sea level. Marino Ballena National Park is mostly a marine park. It was created to protect the **dolphins and whales**, which can be observed most of the year, with the exception of May and June. The best months are August, September, and October, followed by January and February.
