Day 1, 14 Sep 23

 Private Transfer IN from Airport to Hotel / Transport + Guide

The hotel for tonight is close to **San Jose city**, located 25-15 minutes away from the airport. 

Tortuguero

Tortuguero is located in the north Caribbean of Costa Rica. Tortuguero is one of the most remote places in Costa Rica and is only accessible by boat or plane. This little village with strong **Afro-Caribbean roots** is best known for attracting hordes of sea turtles such as **Leatherback, Loggerhead, and Hawksbill turtles**. While peak turtle season is in July and August, the park and village have begun to attract travelers year-round. Tortuguero is great for families and adventure travelers to go on **jungle hikes**, do a **boat tour** in the canals of the National Park, or just relax at the lodge. The Canals of Tortuguero are known as Costa Rica's Amazon-like rainforest there are more of **800 species of wildlife**, especially many types of birds.

After breakfast, you will continue to La Pavona dock, there you will board the special boat that will take you to the lodge immersed in the jungle.

This afternoon, you will have a **guided tour to the Village of Tortuguero** and walk around the town to learn about the relaxed way of life in the Caribbean. Your guide will explain to you how this village developed and why they changed their minds about **turtle conservation**.

The rest of the day is at your leisure; you can relax at the **swimming pool**, take a cocktail admiring the river lagoon or spend the afternoon on the beach.



This tour visits **the iguana zoo-farm** of the **KEKOLDY indigenous** reservation, a place where an indigenous family dedicates itself to the **reproduction of the Green Iguana**, a species that was in danger of extinction and thanks to initiatives such as these, it has been recovering . Then, in the **Bri Bri indigenous reserve**, an indigenous family is visited where a tour is made in a **medicinal plant garden**, followed by a demonstration of **chocolate production**. Cocoa within the Bribri culture is very important since they use it as purification, food and medicine and then they will take a short tour to see medicinal plants, obtain fiber and the weaving process. In the last stage of the tour you will visit a **waterfall** where you can take a bath and a small fruit-based snack.

Sloth Sanctuary Tour

At Selvatura Park's Sloth Sanctuary you will have a close experience with some **sloth specimens**. In the natural exhibit, sloths can travel freely between paths specially created so that they can roam among the trees and foliage of the exhibition. This provides a safe distance that allows observation while preventing as much stress on the animals as possible. These **beautiful mammals** have arrived at the sanctuary as refugees from the effects of poaching, habitat destruction, orphanage, illness and accidents among other reasons that prevent them from being reintroduced to their natural habitat.

Monteverde Cloud Forest Reserve, Guided Walking Tour

The tour is essentially a natural history walk in which you will learn about **the incredible diversity of flora and fauna** and many of the unique relationships various cloud forest species have with each other. This walk normally takes about 3 hours.

The **Monteverde Cloud Forest Reserve** is where some of **the best-kept cloud forests** in all of Costa Rica can be found. It is a cloud forest, not a rainforest, due to its elevation of 4,724 feet (1,440 meters) above sea level.

Note: The total stay at the Poas Volcano National Park will be 40 minutes: 10 minutes walking on the trek to get to the **crater viewpoint**, 20 minutes at the crater viewpoint, and 10 minutes walking back. There is no access to Botos Lagoon and in case of fog, there is no extra waiting time all this as a safety measure.

At the Volcano, you will have time to enjoy the **impressive main crater** with its sulfur fumaroles and learn about the volcano activity.

After Poas, you will continue to La Paz Waterfall Garden, you will enjoy a buffet lunch. Here you will find **five waterfalls**, cloud forest, and rain forest, safe hiking trails, aviary with numerous species of birds, insect exhibit, butterfly observatory, capuchin monkeys, black-handed spider monkeys, hummingbird garden with 26 documented species, serpentarium, jaguars, pumas, ocelots, margays, Costa Rican house with petting zoo and ox cart, ranarium, orchid exhibit, heliconia exhibit.

After an exciting tour of the volcano, we will descend to the **historical city of Cartago**. We will stop at the **Virgin of the Angels Basilica** – a famous peregrination site, some of which travel for days or even weeks on foot, in a pilgrimage of faith, to the site.

Next, after you visit the Basilica the next stop is the **Lankester Botanical Gardens**, a University of Costa Rica Center for the investigation that protects more than **800 species of orchids, bromeliads and countless species of other plants**.

Then as a final destination, you will visit the Orosi Valley. Here you will find one of the few remaining **colonial churches** and, in this town,, you will enjoy a tasty typical lunch at one of the local restaurants.
