



Sarapiqui is located in the Heredia province and it has gain popularity because of the **rich biodiversity** as well for the **adventure activities** that can be done here. Surrounded by lush green forests and banana and cacao plantations, Sarapiqui was once just a small port town. Located at the junction of the Puerto Viejo River and Sarapiqui River. In Sarapiqui, several private reserves can be found such as La Tirimbina, La Selva and many others making a great place to **admire nature and wildlife**. As one of Costa Rica's last remaining areas of primary rainforest, Sarapiquí is home to over half of the country's total species of birds. The species **diversity is astounding**, with more than 1,850 plants, 448 birds, 70 species of bat and five of Costa Rica's six felines.



This tour visits **the iguana zoo-farm** of the **KEKOLDY indigenous** reservation, a place where an indigenous family dedicates itself to the **reproduction of the Green Iguana**, a species that was in danger of extinction and thanks to initiatives such as these, it has been recovering . Then, in the **Bri Bri indigenous reserve**, an indigenous family is visited where a tour is made in a **medicinal plant garden**, followed by a demonstration of **chocolate production**. Cocoa within the Bribri culture is very important since they use it as purification, food and medicine and then they will take a short tour to see medicinal plants, obtain fiber and the weaving process. In the last stage of the tour you will visit a **waterfall** where you can take a bath and a small fruit-based snack.

The snorkeling tour is a great way to explore **Cahuita's coral reef** surrounding the tip of the **National Park referred to as Punta Cahuita**. The reef in the National Park is filled with over 240 marine species including wildlife such as **tropical fish, mollusks, nurse sharks, turtles and lobsters**. The equipment will be provided during the **training session** before entering the boat. The boat will take you to the Cahuita National Park. From there **you will snorkel in two different locations to fully explore for around 2 hours**. While in the water you will follow a guide, a nature specialist, who will explain the **coral reef and the lush wildlife**. After the adventure under the water, you will **explore the Cahuita National Park with an expert guide**, you will hike **from Punta Cahuita y Cahuita Town, 7kms**. In the walk you will be able to spot **wonderful trees and beautiful wildlife** such as sloths, capuchin monkey, howler monkey, species of snakes, some colorful birds and butterflies.

Located in the rural part of the Cartago Province, Turrialba combines a charming little town with amazing nature sites such as the Turrialba Volcano, which is currently active and regularly throwing ashes. **The Pacuare and Reventazon river**, perfect for whitewater rafting. The Pacuare river is considered a top river for this sport. Also, the most important **pre-colonial archeological site, Guayabo**, is located in Turrialba, Costa Rica's only pre-Columbian site that is open to public access, these ruins provide a fantastic insight into what life circa 1000 BC to 1400AD must have been like. Turrialba is a farming town. Because they have a very interesting climate being near the Caribbean side in the Central Valley, you will see fields of lettuce, cilantro, sugar cane, coffee, and others. But one of the most famous products from Turrialba is their cheese.

Irazu Volcano National Park

Irazu Volcano, **still active**, last made international headlines when it erupted in 1963 on the day that former **US President John F. Kennedy visited the country**. The volcanic activity has coated the landscape in ash, making the soil highly fertile. The last noticeable activity came in 1996, and since then Irazu has been a quiet giant. Reaching upward of 11,260 ft (3,432 m), Irazu is the **tallest volcano in Costa Rica**. Very few plants grow at the volcano's peak, however. Only those which are acclimated to the harsh conditions can survive. The volcano **has several craters**, two of which are the principal attractions. The larger of the two delves 900 feet (275 m) deep, as steam rises up into the air giving you at nearby viewing stations an amazing sight to behold. The smaller crater, **Diego de la Haya**, dips below the surface 300 ft (91 m) **On a clear day, the Pacific and Caribbean are visible**. There are also **very few animals** in the National Park due to volcanic activity. You can, however, still spot robins, owls, hummingbirds, porcupines, rabbits, coyotes, and foxes.



It is the primary entrance to the **incredibly beautiful Marino Ballena National Park** which protects both coastline and sea. The park is most well-known for the Humpback Whales that migrate here annually to rear their young. The backdrop for the area is just as spectacular with towering **lush green mountains** shrouded in clouds that quickly descend to sea level. Marino Ballena National Park is mostly a marine park. It was created to protect the **dolphins and whales**, which can be observed most of the year, with the exception of May and June. The best months are August, September, and October, followed by January and February.


