Day 1, 30 Nov 23

 Private Transfer IN from Airport to Hotel

Right after you go through immigration and customs one representative will meet you at **the Juan Santamaria International Airport (SJO) exit** to load the luggage into the vehicle and transfer you to the hotel. The hotel for tonight is close to **San Jose city**, located 25-15 minutes away from the airport. During the short drive, you will receive a **brief introduction to Costa Rica** and some recommendations for your trip. The guide will explain your itinerary in detail once you are in the hotel.

Volcanic views grace the landscape and heat several **geothermal hot springs**. A lake and rivers beckon you toward **aquatic adventure**. Refreshing **waterfalls** reward you after **hikes**, offering crisp pools and spectacular views.

Arenal Volcano is one of **Costa Rica's most notable natural features**. Standing at 5,437 feet (1,657 meters), this volcano has been resting (i.e. not active) since 2010. However, it is no less majestic to behold, as it's practically a behemoth against the region's perfect skies. **Rising above the rainforest** that surrounds its base, Arenal Volcano frames the skyline with near-perfect **symmetry**.

Arenal Volcano Walking Tour

The trails in **Arenal National Park** and other nearby **Arenal Reserves** are generally flat and not very strenuous, perfect for a leisurely and informative guided walk with a professional nature guide. You will hike through well-groomed, **easy trails** that skirt the base of the Arenal Volcano and Lake Arenal Area. This part of the Arenal Volcano had sections that were devastated by **the lava flow of 1968**, so some areas have very little vegetation.

This guided walk provides **perfect photo opportunities** and **magnificent views** of the impressive Arenal Volcano, the pristine Lake Arenal and the extinct volcano Cerro Chato. There are parts of each trail that has forested areas where your nature guide will try to spot **birds, monkeys and other animals** in their natural habitat.

Arenal Canopy Adventure & Tarzan Swing

Your tour will begin with a warm welcome and a brief safety speech, after which your equipment will be put on and carefully checked by the bilingual guides. Enjoy this **thrilling aerial adventure** of approximately 3 kilometers, starting from a tower 13 meters high and glide your way down **8 cables**, ranging from 80 meters to 750 meters in length, with an average height of 38 meters.

Speeds will top **60 kilometers per hour!** Each of the **14 platforms**, 5 of which are constructed in extraordinary trees, were strategically designed at varying heights to allow the clients to observe **the rainforest** from different angles and photograph the **awe-inspiring scenery**.

Day 5, 04 Dec 23

Shared Transfer from Arenal to Monteverde, Lake Crossing

The trip combines comfortable **door to door** minivan transfers with a fun and **scenic cruise** across the tranquil **Lake Arenal**, where you will experience beautiful views of **the majestic volcano** and the forested **Tilaran Mountain Range**. You will also have the chance to see a variety of wetland birds such as kingfishers, flycatchers, waders and other exotic species that abound on the lakeshore.

You will be picked up from your hotel in **Arenal** and be driven to the Lake Arenal dam, where you will board a **covered boat**. This is where the scenic 45-minute cruise across the lake begins. Next, you will begin the impressive 1.5-hour journey up the mountainside on a steep road offering stunning views of the lush, green valley. You will be driven directly to your **Monteverde** area hotel.

IMPORTANT: Passengers should expect to carry their bags/luggage to and from the boat. Drivers will do their best to help if you have any problems with carrying heavy bags. Just let them know in advance.

Home to cool, **misty cloud forests**, and deep **green foliage almost everywhere** you look, there's no mistaking that you've stepped away from everyday life. Monteverde is translated as "green mountain", and once you've reached the mountaintop, you'll first come upon the quaint town of **Santa Elena**. Here you'll find gift stores, accommodations, a bus stop, restaurants, cafes, a supermarket, banks and much more. Though Monteverde proper does not have a town center, it is comprised of a dirt road that leads to the **Cloud Forest Reserve**. Spread out along this walkable road are hotels, cafes, restaurants, galleries, and **excellent views**

This is a **night walk** through a private **cloud forest reserve** of approximately 2 hours. This is a slow walk ideal to observe the nightlife of the forest. You will be able to see **sloths, night birds, snakes, nocturnal insects, armadillos, tarantulas, scorpions**, among others. You will be provided with a flashlight. You will be accompanied by an experienced guide with great knowledge of the area.

Sky Tram / Sky Walk Guided

You will have a combination of **two wonderful activities** in this tour, the **Sky Tram and the Sky Walk**. In the Sky Tram you will ascend along a **beautiful cloud forest ridge** and it will allow you for stops along the way to observe **plant and animal** life. The duration of the tram takes about 20 minutes before arriving at an observatory platform. Perfect place for a picture!

After observing the forest from the **gondola**, now is time for you to discover the forest from the ground and from the canopy in the trails and **hanging bridges** of the Sky Walk.

The hike at Sky Walk offers a more peaceful introduction to exploring **Monteverde Cloud Forest** on a 2.5km (1.5mi) circuit trail that goes through distinct levels of the wonderfully diverse ecosystem. Sky Walk uses these trails and a series of suspension bridges for a one on one experience with the flora and fauna of the forest canopy. You will hike deep into these **magical tropical forests** to admire nature from a **distinct perspective**. Crossing hanging bridges with complete views of the forest canopy, and from the floor of the forest a naturalist.

Monteverde Cloud Forest Reserve, Guided Walking Tour

The tour is essentially a natural history walk in which you will learn about **the incredible diversity of flora and fauna** and many of the unique relationships various cloud forest species have with each other. Guides are equipped with a spotting telescope as well as binoculars and several informational guidebooks. Be sure to bring your cameras, as you can take pictures through the guide's scope. This walk normally takes about 3 hours.

The **Monteverde Cloud Forest Reserve** is where some of **the best-kept cloud forests** in all of Costa Rica can be found. It is a cloud forest, not a rainforest, due to its elevation of 4,724 feet (1,440 meters) above sea level.

The boat will anchor at two different sites close to Cano Island, and your snorkeling guide will point out the diverse species living just below the surface. The dark, volcanic rock and the open water around the Island are home to a variety of marine life including Olive Ridley and Hawksbill Sea Turtles, White-Tipped Sharks, several species of Moray Eels, Mobula, Eagle or Sting Rays, big Cubera Snapper, schools of Horse-Eyed Jacks, King Angelfish, Grunts, and Barracudas.
