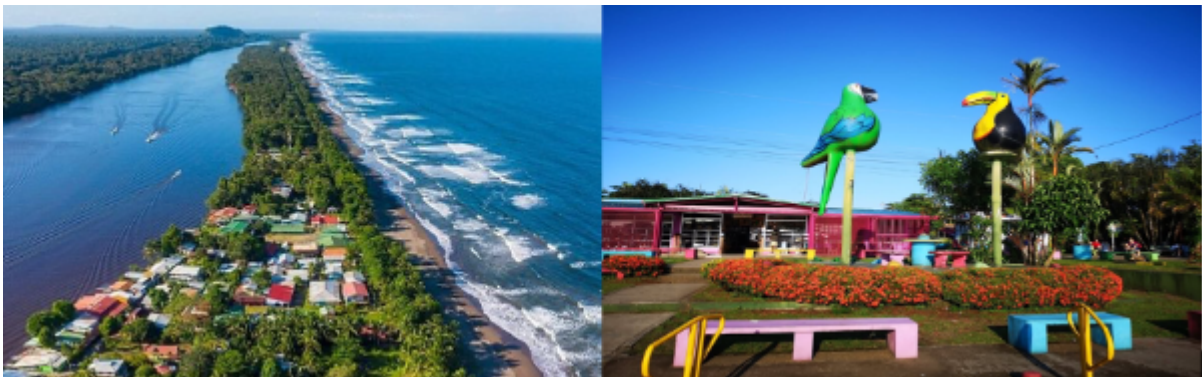

You will raft through the incredible rainforest on **19 miles of Class III-IV whitewater**. Cascading waterfalls, lush forest, exotic plants, birds and other animals, and exciting rapids make this a tropical adventure packed with rich experiences that you'll remember forever.

At the end of your rafting trip, you'll return to the operations center for a delicious **lunch**, and time to shower and change clothes. Then, you will take transportation to your next destination.

La Fortuna is home to the greater Arenal recreation area, the entire region is paradise on Earth for **outdoor adventurers**. Volcanic views grace the landscape and heat several **geothermal hot springs**. A lake and rivers beckon you toward **aquatic adventure**. Refreshing **waterfalls** reward you after **hikes**, offering crisp pools and spectacular views.

Arenal Volcano is one of **Costa Rica's most notable natural features**. Standing at 5,437 feet (1,657 meters), this volcano has been resting (i.e. not active) since 2010. However, it is no less majestic to behold, as it's practically a behemoth against the region's perfect skies. **Rising above the rainforest** that surrounds its base, Arenal Volcano frames the skyline with near-perfect **symmetry**.

You will also have the chance to see a variety of wetland birds such as kingfishers, flycatchers, waders and other exotic species that abound on the lakeshore. You will be picked up from your hotel in **Arenal** and be driven to the Lake Arenal dam, where you will board a **covered boat**. This is where the scenic 45-minute cruise across the lake begins. Next, you will begin the impressive 1.5-hour journey up the mountainside on a steep road offering stunning views of the lush, green valley. You will be driven directly to your **Monteverde** area hotel.

Monteverde Cloud Forest Reserve, Guided Walking Tour / / Regular

The tour is essentially a natural history walk in which you will learn about **the incredible diversity of flora and fauna** and many of the unique relationships various cloud forest species have with each other. Guides are equipped with a spotting telescope as well as binoculars and several informational guidebooks. Be sure to bring your cameras, as you can take pictures through the guide's scope. This walk normally takes about 3 hours.

The **Monteverde Cloud Forest Reserve** is where some of **the best-kept cloud forests** in all of Costa Rica can be found. It is a cloud forest, not a rainforest, due to its elevation of 4,724 feet (1,440 meters) above sea level.

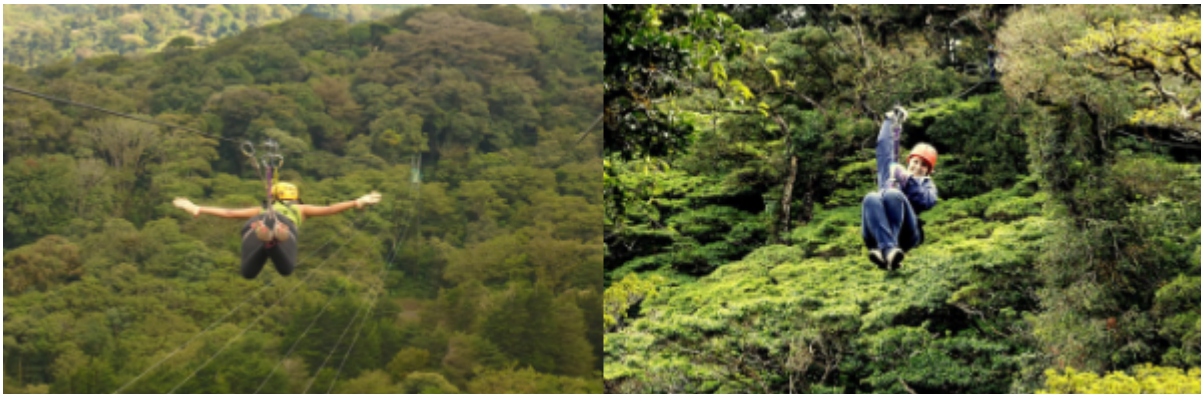

Located in the south Pacific of Costa Rica. Uvita is a small town, here are small shops, and souvenirs place. Nightlife is not big here in Uvita but there is still several bar and restaurant options. The town itself is spread out and stretches from the beach area and back into the **mountains**.

It is the primary entrance to the **incredibly beautiful Marino Ballena National Park** which protects both coastline and sea. The park is most well-known for the Humpback Whales that migrate here annually to rear their young. The backdrop for the area is just as spectacular with towering **lush green mountains** shrouded in clouds that quickly descend to sea level. Marino Ballena National Park is mostly a marine park. It was created to protect the **dolphins and whales**, which can be observed most of the year, with the exception of May and June. The best months are August, September, and October, followed by January and February.

The Corcovado National Park Day Tour is a full-day tour and you will visit the **San Pedrillo Ranger Station section**.

Upon arrival at San Pedrillo Ranger Station, you will be prepared for **two guided walks** along two different trails and observe beautiful flora and fauna in the most biologically intense place on earth.

The first walk takes around **3 hours** and the second walk about **1 hour and a half**. During the walks, you will be able to see some mammals such as monkeys, sloths, coatis, and tapirs as well as a great variety of birds, plants, and trees with over one hundred years of existence and in danger of extinction. The second trail is shorter with a **bit broken ground** and 1.5 hours. Where is possible to observe more birds, mammals and very interesting vegetation and even crocodiles. Also at the end of the trail, you will visit a small waterfall

During boat transit, you may observe whales (seasonally), dolphins, turtles, marine birds and fantastic views of the southern pacific Osa coastline.
