Private Transfer IN from Airport to Hotel

Day 6, 02 Jul 23

Shuttle Transfer from Manuel Antonio to Sierpe

Travel time: 1 hour and 45 minutes.



Located on the wild and untamed **Osa Peninsula**, the Corcovado National Park embodies **Costa Rica's most truly splendid wonders**. Breathtaking **rainforests**, rugged natural beauty, **secluded and untouched beaches** await the arrival of **eco adventurers** and **wildlife admirers**, alike. Prepare to be touched, moved and inspired by the unforgettable beauty of this area.

The Osa Peninsula offers an **abundance of activities**, affordable and luxury lodging, and adventure tours for every budget. Here you'll experience **a completely different lifestyle** than the rest of the country in what has been referred to as the "**Amazon of Costa Rica**". Housing more than 400 species of birds, 139 of mammals and 116 of amphibians, this virtually untouched jewel is easily **one of the world's most bio-diverse eco-tourism destinations**.







Boat transfer from Sierpe to Drake

The boat transfer from Sierpe to Drake Bay takes about **1 hour**. The first 40 minutes of the boat ride are on the **Sierpe River** where you can enjoy the mangroves and some animals, **as crocodiles and birds**. After crossing the river's mouth, we will be navigating on the sea for 20 more minutes. Every guest will be **dropped off hotel**.

Note: it is a wet landing so, wear shoes easy to remove, sandals or water shoes.

Walking tour to Cocovado National Park in Sirena Station / Lunch included

The Corcovado National Park is home to over 140 species of mammals, 120 species of reptiles, 6000 species of insects and over 400 kinds of birds. Besides, in this spectacular park, there are 500 species of trees and 150 species of orchids. That is why the National Geographic Magazine called it the **most biologically intense place on Earth**.

You will visit **Sirena Station** is located in the center of the park, there are more chances to spot animals such as tapirs, monkeys, crocodiles, birds and a lot more. During this tour, you will be exploring the trails walking in the jungle and along the coastline for **5 hours approximately**.





Day 8, 04 Jul 23



Snorkeling at Cano Island / Lunch included

Cano Island is an amazing **marine biological reserve** located 45 minutes from Drake, by boat. The real beauty of Cano Island is not found on its land, but **underwater**. The reefs and waters around it are famous for snorkeling and offer diving at its best. While you snorkel, you are going be able to see over 15 species of **corals**, huge banks of **colorful fishes**, **rays**, **sharks**, **morays**, **and turtles**. It is also very common to see **dolphins and whales**. For lunch, you will go to a stunning San Josecito beach, where you will be able to do some hiking, more snorkeling or just relax
