Day 1, 27 Jun 23

Private Transfer IN from Airport to Hotel

Right after you go through immigration and customs one representative will meet you at **the Juan Santamaria International Airport (SJO) exit** to load the luggage into the vehicle and transfer you to the hotel. The hotel for tonight is close to **San Jose city**, located 25-15 minutes away from the airport. During the short drive, you will receive a **brief introduction to Costa Rica** and some recommendations for your trip. The guide will explain your itinerary in detail once you are in the hotel.

Costa Rica's capital and the **largest city in the country**, San Jose is considered to be among the most cosmopolitan cities in Latin America. Downtown San Jose is the busiest part of town. A maze of streets and avenues, here you can find most of the city's museums as well as several hotels and plazas.

In the center of the city, several attractions can be found, such as the **National Theater**, **the National Museum**, **and the Jade Museum**. Also, several parks like **Plaza de La Cultura and Parque Morazan** are interesting places to visit. In San Jose exist a wide variety for gastronomic, each corner of the city has great restaurants or the famous **Barrio Escalante**, a gastronomic center where high-quality food is offered. But for more local and typical food the central market offers tasty food.

Day 2, 28 Jun 23 Doka Coffee Tour & Poas Volcano / Breakfast

Today a professional guide will meet you at the hotel, to take you for a very interesting tour, you will visit **three sites and learn a lot of Costa Rica culture and nature.**

The first stop will be **Doka Coffee Estate** for a delicious breakfast. Then you will learn about the coffee in an actual coffee plantation where you will learn the ancient techniques used by the experts to produce some of the best coffee in Costa Rica. The careful process involved in the cultivation, harvesting, and roasting.

After the coffee tour, the next destination is the Poas Volcano National Park,

Note: The total stay at the Poas Volcano National Park will be 40 minutes: 10 minutes walking on the trek to get to the **crater viewpoint**, 20 minutes at the crater viewpoint, and 10 minutes walking back. There is no access to Botos Lagoon and in case of fog, there is no extra waiting time all this as a safety measure.

At the Volcano, you will have time to enjoy the **impressive main crater** with its sulfur fumaroles and learn about the volcano activity.

After Poas, you will continue to La Paz Waterfall Garden, you will enjoy a buffet lunch. Here you will find **five waterfalls**, cloud forest, and rain forest, safe hiking trails, aviary with numerous species of birds, insect exhibit, butterfly observatory, capuchin monkeys, black-handed spider monkeys, hummingbird garden with 26 documented species, serpentarium, jaguars, pumas, ocelots, margays, Costa Rican house with petting zoo and ox cart, ranarium, orchid exhibit, heliconia exhibit.

Day 3, 29 Jun 23

Transfer to Arenal Volcano with Safari Float Sarapiqui River / Lunch included

After getting picked up from your hotel, you'll drive through the beautiful Costa Rican back roads to a private put-in at the Sarapiqui River, equipped with bathrooms and change rooms. Your professional guide will start the day off by providing paddling and **safety instructions** and then suiting you up with safety gear to prepare for your adventure.

After getting settled with your lifejacket and paddle, you will be ready to enjoy the sights and **sounds of the rainforest** and the tranquil experience of slowly paddling downriver to not miss anything. Enjoy 2.5 hours immersed in the lush tropical rainforest, floating along the Sarapiqui River which lies next to important reserves renowned for their biodiversity.

Exotic **amphibians**, **countless tropical birds**, **otters**, **fish**, **sloths**, **iguanas**, and incredible **flora** will make this experience unforgettable.

La Fortuna is home to the greater Arenal recreation area, the entire region is paradise on Earth for **outdoor adventurers.** Volcanic views grace the landscape and heat several **geothermal hot springs**. A lake and rivers beckon you toward **aquatic adventure**. Refreshing **waterfalls** reward you after **hikes**, offering crisp pools and spectacular views.

Arenal Volcano is one of **Costa Rica's most notable natural features**. Standing at 5,437 feet (1,657 meters), this volcano has been resting (i.e. not active) since 2010. However, it is no less majestic to behold, as it's practically a behemoth against the region's perfect skies. **Rising above the rainforest** that surrounds its base, Arenal Volcano frames the skyline with near-perfect **symmetry**.




Day 4, 30 Jun 23

The sweet smiling face of the **Costa Rican sloth** is rapidly becoming the iconic symbol of the country's amazing **rainforest wildlife**. All set, you will walk for about 1.2 kilometers through the beautiful rainforest looking for our lazy friend, the sloth.

You will be searching out both **2-toed** and **3-toed sloths**. Although similar, they have distinct differences. The 2-toed Sloth, being nocturnal, can be found sleeping high up in the treetops. More active during daytime hours, the 3-toed Sloth slowly moves through the branches eating leaves, often with a young sloth hugging on for the ride.

And as a bonus, you will also get great views of a **variety of birds, brightly-colored toucans, iguanas**, and more.

Arenal Volcano Walking Tour

The trails in **Arenal National Park** and other nearby **Arenal Reserves** are generally flat and not very strenuous, perfect for a leisurely and informative guided walk with a professional nature guide. You will hike through well-groomed, **easy trails** that skirt the base of the Arenal Volcano and Lake Arenal Area. This part of the Arenal Volcano had sections that were devastated by **the lava flow of 1968**, so some areas have very little vegetation.

This guided walk provides **perfect photo opportunities** and **magnificent views** of the impressive Arenal Volcano, the pristine Lake Arenal and the extinct volcano Cerro Chato. There are parts of each trail that has forested areas where your nature guide will try to spot **birds**, **monkeys and other animals** in their natural habitat.

Don't forget to point out the **caimans, sloths, crocodiles, boas, white face monkeys, egrets**, and so many more species of wildlife, as your boat leisurely winds its way through the mangrove canals along the gentle currents of the coastal tides. And finally, end your adventure with a **meal** in a typical Costa Rican flavor at a local restaurant before you return to your hotel.

Note that the tour's start time depends on the tide.
