Day 1, 30 Dec 23

Private Transfer IN from Airport to Hotel



Indigenous Reserve Kekoldi & Bribri / Lunch included

This tour visits **the iguana zoo-farm** of the **KEKOLDY indigenous** reservation, a place where an indigenous family dedicates itself to the **reproduction of the Green Iguana**, a species that was in danger of extinction and thanks to initiatives such as these, it has been recovering. Then, in the **Bri Bri indigenous reserve**, an indigenous family is visited where a tour is made in a **medicinal plant garden**, followed by a demonstration of **chocolate production**.

Cocoa within the Bribri culture is very important since they use it as purification, food and medicine and then they will take a short tour to see medicinal plants, obtain fiber and the weaving process. In the last stage of the tour you will visit a **waterfall** where you can take a bath and a small fruit-based snack.







Day 5, 03 Jan 24

Selfdrive from Puerto Viejo To Arenal Volcano

La Fortuna is home to the greater Arenal recreation area, the entire region is paradise on Earth for **outdoor adventurers.** Volcanic views grace the landscape and heat several **geothermal hot springs**. A lake and rivers beckon you toward **aquatic adventure**. Refreshing **waterfalls** reward you after **hikes**, offering crisp pools and spectacular views.

Arenal Volcano is one of **Costa Rica's most notable natural features**. Standing at 5,437 feet (1,657 meters), this volcano has been resting (i.e. not active) since 2010. However, it is no less majestic to behold, as it's practically a behemoth against the region's perfect skies. **Rising above the rainforest** that surrounds its base, Arenal Volcano frames the skyline with near-perfect **symmetry**.


Day 6, 04 Jan 24











You will love the **hike down** to this waterfall near the town of La Fortuna because you can see all of **the natural beauty of the rainforest** as well as the birds and wildlife that live there. Once you arrive at the **La Fortuna Waterfall**, prepare to be blown away by the beauty of this impressive waterfall! You will also be able to swim and take amazing photos!

Get ready because there are 500 steps to get down to the waterfall and of course 500 steps to get back up. Many people take breaks on their way to soak up **the lush rainforest**, **tropical birds** and variety of wildlife that you may be lucky enough to see. When you reach the bottom, you will be blown away by the beauty of **this towering waterfall** and have plenty of opportunities to relax on the rocks and admire the views. You can also **take a swim** in the cool, refreshing clear-water pools along the left-hand side of the waterfall.

You can rinse off in the showers and change into dry clothes and take part in a delicious tropical fruit snack with your guide.









Arenal Volcano Walking Tour

The trails in **Arenal National Park** and other nearby **Arenal Reserves** are generally flat and not very strenuous, perfect for a leisurely and informative guided walk with a professional nature guide. You will hike through well-groomed, **easy trails** that skirt the base of the Arenal Volcano and Lake Arenal Area. This part of the Arenal Volcano had sections that were devastated by **the lava flow of 1968**, so some areas have very little vegetation.

This guided walk provides **perfect photo opportunities** and **magnificent views** of the impressive Arenal Volcano, the pristine Lake Arenal and the extinct volcano Cerro Chato. There are parts of each trail that has forested areas where your nature guide will try to spot **birds**, **monkeys and other animals** in their natural habitat.







Day 7, 05 Jan 24

Jungle Safari Float on Sarapiqui River / Lunch included

Come see the abundance of nature and wildlife that Costa Rica has to offer! This Costa Rica Safari Float is a smooth, two-hour paddle down the quiet, lower section of the Sarapiqui River and great for nature lovers of all ages especially children and their parents! Your bilingual nature guide will paddle and steer your boat as you float down the river and point out all of the exotic wildlife such as **birds**, **frogs**, **insects**, **and monkeys** in the Costa Rica rainforest!

Your eagle-eyed guide will show off Costa Rica's amazing wildlife as he points out a wide array of plant and animal species. You'll float next to the Mesoamerican Biological Corridor (San Juan La Selva Biological Corridor) where there is a good possibility of seeing **sloths**, **howler monkeys, lizards, and even black river otters.**

For those who want to be even closer to nature, you will have the chance to get out of the raft and into the river and refresh yourself as we go down the river.










Day 8, 06 Jan 24

Spread out along this walkable road are hotels, cafes, restaurants, galleries, and **excellent views**
